(HILL HOUSE LANE, BRINDLE, SOUTH RIBBLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hill House Lane, Brindle from its junction with B5256 Sandy Lane, for a distance of 198 metres, in a north-westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Tuesday 8th October 2024 until 1530 hours on Thursday 10th October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

B5256 Sandy Lane – Windmill Lane – Gowans Lane – Oram Road – Hill House Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the safety of the engineers for cabling and jointing works to be carried out.
