SABDEN ROAD, HIGHAM, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sabden Road, Higham from its junction with Higham Hall Road to outside property number 30 Sabden Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative daily from 0700 hours until 2000 hours on Monday 23rd September 2024 until Friday 27th September 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:
 Back Lane Stump Hall Road Guide Lane Barrowford Road –

 Higham Hall Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow fibre networking maintenance works to be carried out.
