LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BELVEDERE ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (PART REVOCATION AND PROHIBITION OF LOADING/UNLOADING) ORDER 2010

The County Council of Lancashire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) and (3) of and Part 1V of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Part Revocation

That part of the "Lancashire County Council (Burnley Borough Area)(On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009", Schedule 11.087 No Waiting Saturday 1pm-6pm and Tuesday 6pm-10pm, Item (5), insofar as it relates to Belvedere Road, Burnley, westerly side, from a point approximately 14 metres north of Blakey Street to a point approximately 15 metres south of its junction with Ridge Road, is hereby revoked.

2. Prohibition of Loading / Unloading

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, or a Cicil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, to be loaded or unloaded, between 10am-10pm each day, in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

3. Exception to Prohibition of Loading / Unloading

Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the prohibited period, in the length of road referred to therein, for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- a) a person to board or alight the vehicle;
- b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following:
 - i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads;
 - the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus or the exercise of any other statutory power or duty for the maintenance and supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in Section 4 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- the vehicle to be used for the purposes of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;

- d) the vehicle to be used for delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- e) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- f) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road for so long as such waiting by the vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral.

4. Miscellaneous

The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

5. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the 16th August 2010 and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Belvedere Road, Burnley, Burnley Borough) (Part Revocation and Prohibition of Loading / Unloading) Order 2010.

SCHEDULE

Introduce No Loading/Unloading 10am-10pm each day on the following lengths of Belvedere Road, Burnley:

- Easterly side, from a point approximately 6 metres north of the centreline of Harry Potts Way for a distance of approximately 66 metres in a northerly direction;
- b) On its easterly side from a point approximately 92.0 metres north of the centreline of Harry Potts Way for a distance of approximately 144 metres in a northerly direction.
- c) Easterly side, from a point approximately 3.5 metres south of the centreline of Holcombe Drive for a distance of approximately 38 metres in a southerly direction;
- d) Westerly side, from a point approximately 5.5 metres north of the centreline of A671 Yorkshire Street, for a distance of approximately 56 metres in a northerly direction;
- e) Westerly side, from a point approximately 22 metres south of the centreline of Ridge Road to a point approximately 11 metres north of the centreline of Ridge Road.
