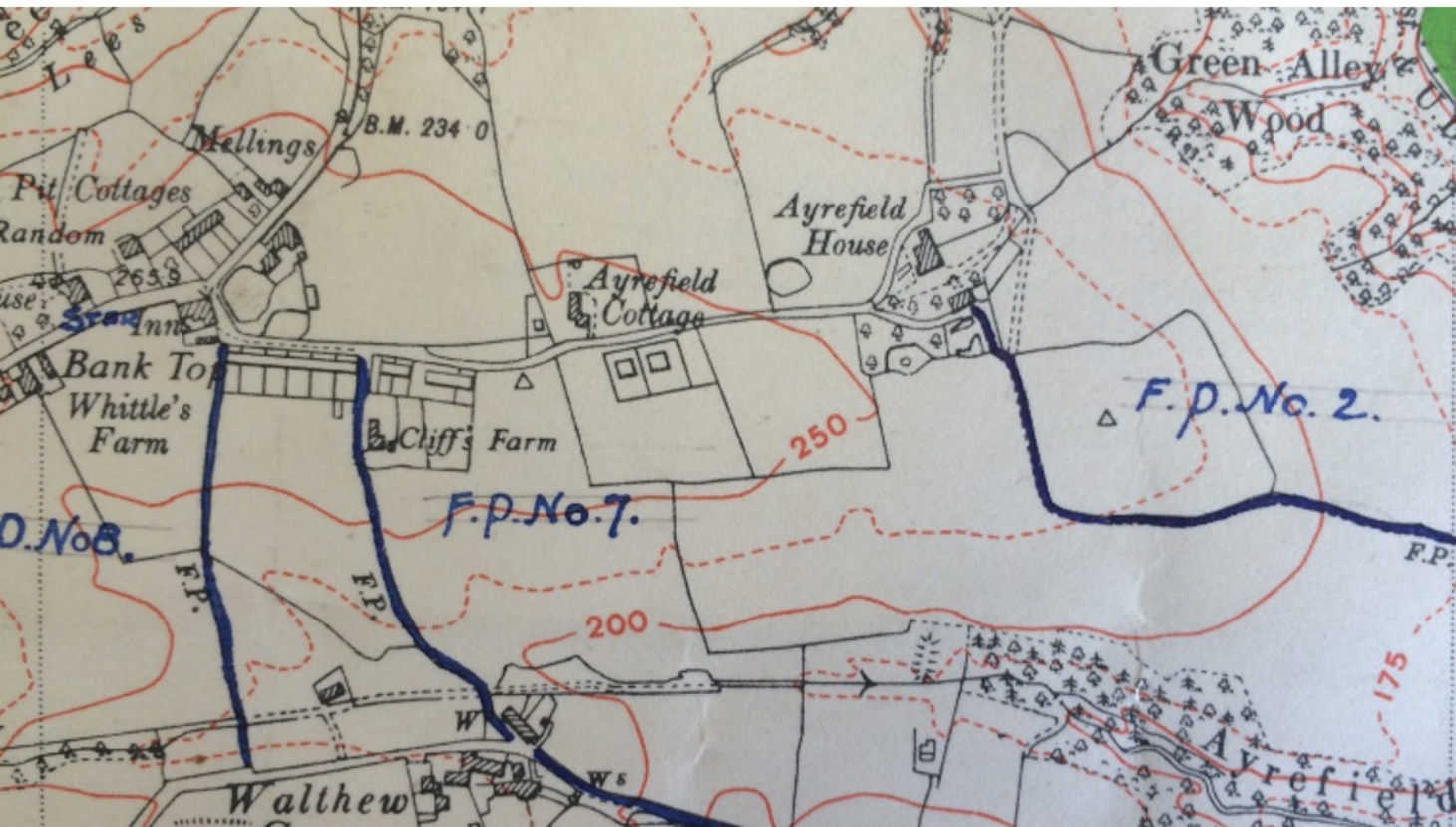

SURVEY OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY.

APPLEY BRIDGE and ROBY MILL and VILLAGE.

No. of path.	Kind of path.	Position.	Length in Miles.
✓ 1.	F.P.	Commencing in cart way, close to Speakman's shop, Appley Lane and leading Westerly for approximately 700' thence Southerly along line of hedge approximately 1,000', thence Westerly along hedge line to reach and pass through farm yard to Halliwell Farm and road to reach Holland Lees Road.	.47 miles.
✓ 2.	F.P.	From point East of Ayrefield House along line of 500' Southerly thence Westerly to Weir near Dean Cottage.	.50 miles.
✓ 3.	F.P.	Southerly from Dean Cottage Weir, to join to Footbridge crossing boundary stream at Head of Dean Wood.	.26 miles. ?
✓ 4.	F.P.	Commencing at Stepping stones in Dean Wood stream, thence N. to junction point to Ayrefield Road and to Footpath leading to Footbridge as F.P. 3.	.24 miles. ?
✓ 5.	F.P.	Commencing at Footbridge as F.P. 3. and turning Westerly to join up with C.R.R. 6., known as Whitley Road.	.50 miles. ?
✓ 6.	C.R.R. F.P.	Cart road commencing at Walthew Green Farm and known as Whitley Road proceeding S. Easterly to point near entrance to Dean Wood and thence S.W. along line of hedge to join Lafford Lane in hollow between the Hollies in the Dean Farm and Dean House Lafford Lane.	.94 miles.
✓ 7.	F.P.	From Ayrefield Road past Cliff's Farm in Southerly direction to join with Walthew Green close to Walthew Green Farm.	.16 miles.
✓ 8.	F.P.	From point at corner at rear of Star Inn thence Southerly to meet Walthew Green Road at point approximately 500 feet West of Walthew Green Farm.	.19 miles.
✓ 9.	F.P.	From C.R.R. ^{F.P.} 6. above leading E.S.E. to Dean Wood stream. Stepping stones and boundary of district. Path passes through the wood.	.13 miles.
✓ 10.	F.P.	From point just South of Dean House, Lafford Lane along hedge side in E.S.E. direction to entry to Dean Wood turning in Wood gradually to Northerly direction, through the wood. Close to stream thence by stepping stones across stream into Orrell U.D.C. Returning across stepping stones about 200' N. and thence along stream side to join F.P. 9.	.50 miles.
