
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(COULSTON ROAD, LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY)
(PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a zebra crossing in Coulston Road, Lancaster, from a point 5.5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Cork Road for a distance of 31 metres in a north easterly direction.



## **Statement of Reasons**

It is proposed to introduce a zebra crossing on Coulston Road to provide safer road crossing facilities and improve links for pedestrians and cyclists between the proposed residential development and the existing amenities and bus stops on the southern side of Coulston Road

The proposals are being pursued as part of a Section 278 Agreement under the Highways Act 1980 as part of a new housing development.
