OLD MOSS LANE, DOWNHOLLAND, WEST LANCASHIRE (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Old Moss Lane, Downholland from either side of Moss Bridge Station.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2024 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Road closure Point East Side Moss Bridge Station — Travel along Old Moss Lane, past junction Riding Lane – Continue straight on to Old Lane past Back Lane Junction – Turn right School Lane – follow on to Black-A-Moor-Lane - right turn Altcar Lane – right at T Junction of Wood Lane – continue on to Causeway Lane – turn right at Broad Lane – turn left at Lord Sefton Way – turn right Formby Bypass – turn right Downholland Moss Lane – continue on to Moss Lane – diversion end on West Side Moss Bridge Station.

Road Closure on West Side Moss Bridge Station - travel West on Moss Lane, onto Downholland Moss Lane – turn left on to Formby Bypass – turn left on to Lord Sefton Way - turn right on to Broad Lane – turn left on to Causeway Lane – straight on to Altcar Lane – turn left on to Black-a-Moor-Lane – on to School Lane – turn left on to Old Lane – carry on to Old Moss Lane - diversion end East Side Moss Bridge Station.

The temporary prohibition is necessary for the critical safety of the public due to the unsafe bridge condition.
