NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 11 September 2024 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- a) Burnley Road, Loveclough, Rossendale, the west side, from a point 43 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Great Clough Drive for a distance of 86 metres in a northerly direction;
- b) Great Clough Drive, Loveclough, Rossendale, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Burnley Road for a distance of 20.5 metres in a westerly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 16 September 2024.
