(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Skipton Road, South of Gisburn Road, Barnoldswick from its junction with Valley Drive for approximately 60 metres in a south westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 14th October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Skipton Road, South of Gisburn – Skipton Road, Barnoldswick - Fernlea Avenue, Barnoldswick – Essex Street, Barnoldswick – Kelbrook Road, Barnoldswick – Kelbrook Road, Salterforth – Kelbrook Road, Kelbrook – Colne Road, Kelbrook- Colne Road, Sough – Colne Road, Earby – Skipton Road, Earby – Colne and Broughton Road, Thornton-In-Craven – Church Road, Thornton-In-Craven and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a crane being rigged for the removal of a mast to be carried out.
