(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear Blackburn Road, Accrington from number 210 to number 228.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> November 2024 to Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Lister Street – Blackburn road – Tremellen Street and vice versa
5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained

The temporary prohibition is necessary to install long sided connection and to disconnect the old lead supply to be carried out by Network Plus.
