BACK 1 TO 21 ASHLEIGH STREET, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back 1 to 21 Ashleigh Street, Preston from the rear of number 1 to the rear of number 3 Ashleigh Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 11th November 2024 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 13th November 2-24 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Back London Road 171 to 181 - Ephraim Street – Back Brockholes View 19 to 29 and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to replace old lead supply pipe works to be carried out.
