**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of to proceed over that length of Rycliffe Street, Padiham, Burnley from its junction with Cophurst Street for a distance of 19 metres in an easterly direction.
  - 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
  - 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 08:00 hours on Monday 2nd December 2024 to 18:00 hours on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
  - 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
  - 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Cophurst Street – Hirst Street – Higham Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to replace high risk gas main works undertaken by Cadent Gas.
