RYCLIFFE STREET, PADIHAM, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of to proceed over that length of Rycliffe Street, Padiham, Burnley from its junction with Cophurst Street for a distance of 19 metres in an easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 08:00 hours on Monday 2nd December 2024 to 18:00 hours on Friday 20th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:- Cophurst Street – Hirst Street – Higham Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to replace high risk gas main works undertaken by Cadent Gas.
