(BLACKPOOL ROAD, POULTON LE FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Blackpool Road, Poulton le Fylde for approximately 20 metres either side of Carleton Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2300 hours on Saturday 1st March 2025 until 0700 hours on Sunday 2nd March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Blackpool Old Road – Garstang Road West – Hardhorn Road – Tithebarn Street – Poulton Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow annual level crossing inspection works to be carried out by Network Rail.
