(TORONTO AVENUE & NAVENA AVENUE, FLEETWOOD, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Wyre:
 - i. Toronto Avenue from its junction with Broadway for its full length.
 - ii. Navena Avenue from its junction with Toronto Avenue for its full length.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The Order will be in force <u>daily</u> from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Thursday 14th November 2024 to Friday 22nd November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Works are weather dependent and may be carried out on any of the dates specified.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Larkholme Parade – Northway - Chatsworth Avenue - Wansbeck Avenue

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
