(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Bridge Road, Lancaster from for a distance of approximately 20 metres either side of the rail bridge.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Tuesday 12th November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Bridge Road – A588 Ashton Road – A6 Greaves Road – Bridge Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to remove dangerous sycamore tree falling within distance of the railway be carried out.
