(MIDGE HALL LANE, MOSS SIDE, SOUTH RIBBLE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Midge Hall Lane, Moss Side for a distance of 20 metres either side of its level crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0700 hours until 1600 on Sunday 5th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Midge Hall Lane – Gill Lane – A59 Longton Bypass – A59 Liverpool Road – A59 John Horrocks Way – A582 Penwortham Way – B5253 Flensburg Way – Comet Road – Reiver Road – Longmeanygate and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow level crossing testing works to be carried out.
