NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 09 October 2024 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Kepple Lane, Garstang, the south east side, from a point 23.5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Stanley Gardens for a distance of 139 metres in a south westerly direction;
- b) St Thomas Way, Garstang, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Kepple Lane for a distance of 15 metres in a south easterly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 18 October 2024.
