ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BACK FAZAKERLEY STREET, CANNON STREET, CHAPEL STREET, CLEVELAND STREET, FAZAKERLEY STREET, HIGH STREET, NEW MARKET STREET, CHORLEY, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (REVOCATION, ONE WAY AND PROHIBITION OF DRIVING EXCEPT LOADING)

ORDER 2019

The County Council of Lancashire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. Definitions and Interpretation

For all the purposes of this Order the terms described in this Article shall have the meanings specified:

- a) "Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of Lancashire County Council in accordance with Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;
- b) "Loading" and "Unloading" means the continuous transference from (or to) a Vehicle to (or from) premises adjacent to where the Vehicle is parked of heavy or unmanageable goods that are not designed to be carried by hand other than over a very short distance;
- c) "Penalty Charge Notice" means a notice served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of section 78 of the 2004 Act and supporting regulations;
- d) "Vehicle" means a motor vehicle, a passenger vehicle, a dual-purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle, a motorcycle or an invalid carriage or any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal or mechanical power.

2. Revocations

- a) Those parts of the "Lancashire County Council (Market Street Area, Chorley, Chorley Borough) (Revocation And Prohibition Of Driving) Order 2013" as set out in Schedule 1A to this Order are hereby revoked.
- b) Those parts of the "The Borough Of Chorley (Prohibition Of Driving One-Way Traffic Prohibition Of Right-Hand Turns And Prohibition Of Waiting) Order 1991" as set out in Schedule 1B to this Order are hereby revoked.
- c) Those parts of the "The Borough Of Chorley (Traffic Regulation) Order 1967" as set out in Schedule 1C to this Order are hereby revoked.

3. One Way Traffic Restriction

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any Vehicle, to enter or proceed along the length of road set out in Schedule 2 to this Order, in any direction other than that specified.

4. <u>Prohibition of Driving Except Loading 4.30pm to Midnight and Midnight to 9.30am</u>
Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction of with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Vehicle to proceed at any time, on any day, along any part of the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 3 to this Order, unless that Vehicle is engaged in the Loading or Unloading of goods between the hours of 4.30pm and Midnight and Midnight and 9.30am.

5. <u>Prohibition of Driving Except Loading Tuesday Only 4.30pm to Midnight and Midnight to 9.30am</u>

Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, except upon the direction of with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Vehicle to proceed at any time, on any day, along any part of the length of road referred to in Schedule 4 to this Order, unless that Vehicle is engaged in the Loading or Unloading of goods on Tuesday only, between the hours 4.30pm and Midnight and Midnight and 9.30am.

6. General Exceptions

Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- the Vehicle to be used for the purposes of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road;
- b) the Vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- c) The Vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection the removal of any obstruction to traffic.

7. Exemptions to Articles 4 and 5

Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- a) if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any of the following:
 - i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road;
 - the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near land adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus or the exercise of any other statutory power or duty for the maintenance and supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in Section 4 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.

8. Miscellaneous

The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

9. Effect of Contravention

Failure by a person to comply with any prohibition or restriction contained within this order or any subsequent orders shall constitute a contravention of the same and shall result in the issue by Lancashire County Council and/or it's Agents of a Penalty Charge Notice which shall be payable by such persons in accordance with the legislation.

10. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the 18th day of January 2019 and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Back Fazakerley Street, Cannon Street, Chapel Street, Cleveland Street, Fazakerley Street, High Street, New Market Street, Chorley, Chorley Borough) (Revocation, One Way And Prohibition Of Driving Except Loading) Order 2019"

- c) Cleveland Street (U8439), Chorley, from its junction with High Street (U8437) to it junction with Union Street (U8447), from south to north.
- d) Cleveland Street (U8439), Chorley, from its junction with High Street (U8437) to it junction with Chapel Street (U8805), from north to south.
- e) Fazakerley Street (U8441), Chorley, from its junction with Cleveland Street (U8439) to its junction with Market Street (U8804), from east to west.
- f) High Street (U8437), Chorley, from its junction with Market Street (U8804) to its junction with Cleveland Street (U8439) from west to east.
- g) New Market Street (U8438), Chorley, from its junction with Chapel Street (U8805) to its junction with High Street (U8437), from south to north.

- a) Back Fazakerley Street (X4160), Chorley, from its junction with Cleveland Street (U8439) in a westerly direction, for its entire length.
- b) Cannon Street (U8440), Chorley, from its junction with Cleveland Street (U8439) in a westerly direction, for its entire length.
- c) Chapel Street (U8805), Chorley, from its junction with Cleveland Street (U8439) in an easterly direction, to its junction with Church Street (U8658).
- d) Chapel Street (U8805), Chorley, from its junction with Cleveland Street (U8439) in a westerly direction, to its junction with Market Street (U8804).
- e) Cleveland Street (U8439), Chorley, from its junction with High Street (U8437) in a southerly direction, to its junction with Chapel Street (U8805).
- f) Fazakerley Street (U8441), Chorley, from its junction with Cleveland Street (U8439) in a westerly direction, to its junction with Market Street (U8804).
- g) New Market Street (U8438), Chorley, from its junction with Chapel Street (U8805) in a northerly direction, to its junction with High Street (U8437).
