(HALL LANE, MYERSCOUGH, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Hall Lane, Myerscough from its junction with Garstang Road to its junction with St Michaels Road.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1500 hours on Thursday 16th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

St Michaels Road – Garstang Road – Garstang Bypass Road –
The Avenue – Tarnacre Lane – Garstang Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to exchange a commercial external water meter and boundary box to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
