



ENTWISTLE ROAD, WORSTHOME-WITH-HURSTWOOD  
BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Entwistle Road, Worstome-With-Hurstwood, Burnley from outside number 20 Entwistle Road for a distance of 317 metres in a north westerly direction
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force daily from 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours from Monday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2024 to Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.  
The probation will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
6. Residents access will be maintained to park overnight.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
