INGLEWHITE ROAD, GOOSNARGH, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Inglewhite Road, Goosnargh from the side of School House Barn to approximately 76 metres in a westerly direction from School House Barn.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Langley Lane – Silk Mill Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection works to be carried out.
