ENFIELD ROAD, HUNCOAT, HYNDBYRN BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Enfield Road, Burnley from 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative 00:01 hours to 08:00 hours on Sunday 12th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is:
 Diversion for vehicles under 14.3"
 Enfield Road Station Road Lower gate Road Townley Avenue –
 Higher Gate Road Burnley Road Kingsway Bolton Avenue Whiney Hill Road Enfield Road

Diversion for vehicles over 14.3"

Lower gate Road – Townley Avenue – Higher Gate Road – Burnley Road – Kingsway – Penny House Lane – Robert Street – Whalley Road – Lime Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow rail changing undertaken by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
