ENFIELD ROAD, HUNCOAT, HYNDBYRN BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Enfield Road, Burnley from 20 metres either side of the Level Crossing.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative 00:01 hours to 08:00 hours on Sunday 12th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is:
Diversion for vehicles under 14.3"
Enfield Road – Station Road – Lower gate Road – Townley Avenue – Higher Gate Road – Burnley Road – Kingsway – Bolton Avenue – Whiney Hill Road – Enfield Road

Diversion for vehicles over 14.3"
Lower gate Road – Townley Avenue – Higher Gate Road – Burnley Road – Kingsway – Penny House Lane – Robert Street – Whalley Road – Lime Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow rail changing undertaken by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
