BACK 28-52 BRACEWELL STREET, BARNOLDSWICK, PENDLE BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Back 28-52 Bracewell Street, Barnoldswick from its junction with Edmondson Street to its junction with Back Brogden Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 25th November 2024 until 1700 hours on Thursday 12th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Edmondson Street – Bracewell Street – Back Brogden Street and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Gas main replacement works to be carried out.
