(STANAH ROAD & RIVER ROAD, THORNTON CLEVELEYS, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Wyre:
 - i. Stanah Road from the property 'Birch Cliffe' to the property 'Stanah House Farm.'
 - ii. River Road from its junction with Stanah Road for approximately 45 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours to 1530 hours on Tuesday 3rd December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Stanah Road: Underbank Road – Raikes Road

River Road: Not applicable – no through route

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow desilting works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
