(YORKSHIRE STREET EAST, LANCASHIRE STREET, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (TEMPORARY ONE WAY TRAFFIC) (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE WAY TRAFFIC) (No.2) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.


1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Yorkshire Street East, Morecambe from its junction with Regent Road to its junction with Lancashire Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Friday 10th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is one way via:- Lancashire Street – A589 Marine Road East – Regent Road.

AND FURTHER, during the period of the said closure, the existing one way prohibitions on Lancashire Street, Morecambe from its junction with the A589 Marine Road East to its junction with Yorkshire Street will be temporarily suspended;

AND FURTHER, during the period of the said closure, Motor Vehicles, will be temporarily prohibited from traveling in a South Easterly direction on Lancashire Street, Morecambe over its entire length.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Telecoms Maintenance works using cherry picker to be carried out.
