
(THE SHORE, BOLTON LE SANDS, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of The Shore, Bolton le Sands for a distance of approximately 20 metres either side of the level crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2345 hours on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2025 until 0900 hours on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2025 or until the completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-St Michaels Lane, A6 Byepass Road, A6 Coastal Road, Shore Lane, Pasture Lane, The Shore and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow level crossing works to be carried out.
