LEWTH LANE, INSKIP-WITH-SOWERBY, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lewth Lane, Inskip-with-Sowerby from its junction with Catforth Road to its junction with School Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Friday 25th October 2024 until 1530 hours on Thursday 5th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Catforth Road – School Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow to excavate and lay high voltage cables.
