ON OCTOBER 31ST 2024, 4-5PM (ONLINE)

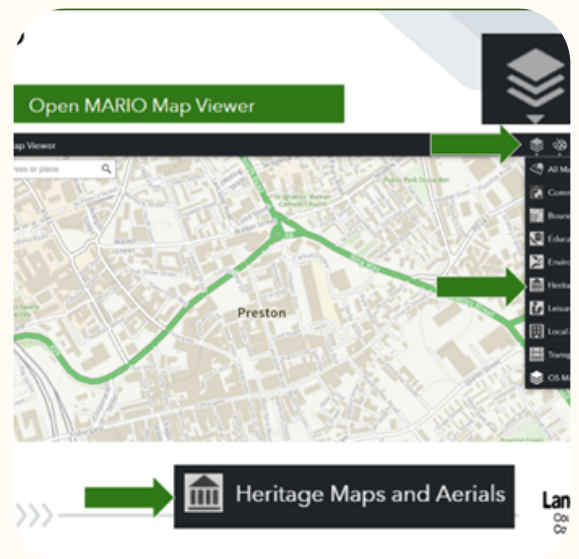
You are invited to a free briefing to help primary schools celebrate the 50th anniversary of the formation of the modern county council.
