(HAZELRIGG LANE, ELLEL, LANCASTER CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Haelrigg Lane from its junction with Barrow Greaves, Ellel to its junction with junction with the private entrance road to Banton House Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from daily between 0800 hours and 1600 hours from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2024 until Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: Hazelrigg Lane Blea Tarn Lane Bowerham Road Barton Road
  – A6 Scotforth Road A6 Preston Lancaster Road A6 Main Road –
  Hazelrigg Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access to works being carried out on private Land.
