(SANDY LANE, HAMBLETON, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Sandy Lane, Hambleton from its northern & western access onto Sandy Lane to its junction with Ryecroft Avenue.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 25th November 2024 until 1800 hours on Friday 6th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Marsh Lane – Green Meadow Lane – Broadpool Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow S278 highway improvement works to be carried out by Millpark Construction.
