(ALDON ROAD, POULTON LE FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Aldon Road, Poulton le Fylde from its junction with Garstang Road East to its junction with Clarke Street.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 6th January 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 8th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Garstang Road East – Bracewell Avenue – Furness Drive –
Clarke Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to excavate 2 x trial holes to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
