## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(ALDON ROAD, POULTON LE FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Aldon Road, Poulton le Fylde from its junction with Garstang Road East to its junction with Clarke Street.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Garstang Road East – Bracewell Avenue – Furness Drive – Clarke Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to excavate 2 x trial holes to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
