(PARK LANE, FORTON, WYRE BOROUGH & GARSTANG ROAD,
COCKERHAM, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway:
 - i. Park Lane, Forton from its merging with Garstang Road for a distance of approximately 150 metres in a south-easterly direction.
 - ii. Garstang Road, Cockerham from its merging with Park Lane for a distance of approximately 45 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours to 1530 hours on Tuesday 14th January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Lancaster Road – Ratcliffe Wharf Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access to telegraph poles to provide fibre overhead cabling to be carried out by BT Openreach.
