FAIRFIELD STREET, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Fairfield Street, Accrington, from junction of Exchange Street for a distance of 400 metres in a north easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 09:30 to 14:30 hours from Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2024 to Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period The probation will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed
- 5. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 6. Residents access will be maintained to park overnight.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway surface dressing patching works to be carried out on behalf of Lancashire County Council
