TODMORDEN ROAD, BRIERCLIFE, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Todmorden Road, Briercliffe from Lower Cockden Farm to Northbank Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Saturday 9th November 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 22nd November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works on high risk carriageway deterioration to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
