(DENFORD AVENUE, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Denford Avenue, Lytham St Annes at its junction with Clifton Drive South for approximately 20 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 2359 hours on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2024 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow immediate sewer repair works to be carried out by Sapphire Utility Solutions on behalf of United Utilities.
