- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Church Avenue, Preston from its junction with Neston Street to its junction with Fishwick Parade.
- 2. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Devonshire Place, Preston from its junction with New Hall Lane to its junction with Church Avenue.
- 3. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 1600 hours on Monday 11th November 2024 until 2359 hours on Friday 15th November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow line maintenance works to be carried out.
