MOUNT STREET, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(b)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Mount Street, Preston from its junction with Fishergate to its junction with Garden Street.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November 2024 until 2359 hours on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Nothing in Article 1 of this Notice shall make it unlawful to proceed over the said road if the vehicle is being used for or in connection with the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said road;
- 5. For the duration of the closure, the Bus Gate on Fishergate between Mount Street and Corporation Street shall be suspended to allow for a safe and legal diversion.
- 6. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent building repair works due to a house fire to be carried out.
