CHURCH AVENUE AND DEVONSHIRE PLACE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Church Avenue, Preston from its junction with Neston Street to its junction with Fishwick Parade.
- 2. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Devonshire Place, Preston from its junction with New Hall Lane to its junction with Church Avenue.
- 1. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 2. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Saturday 16th November 2024 until 2359 hours on Sunday 1st December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow line maintenance works to be carried out.
