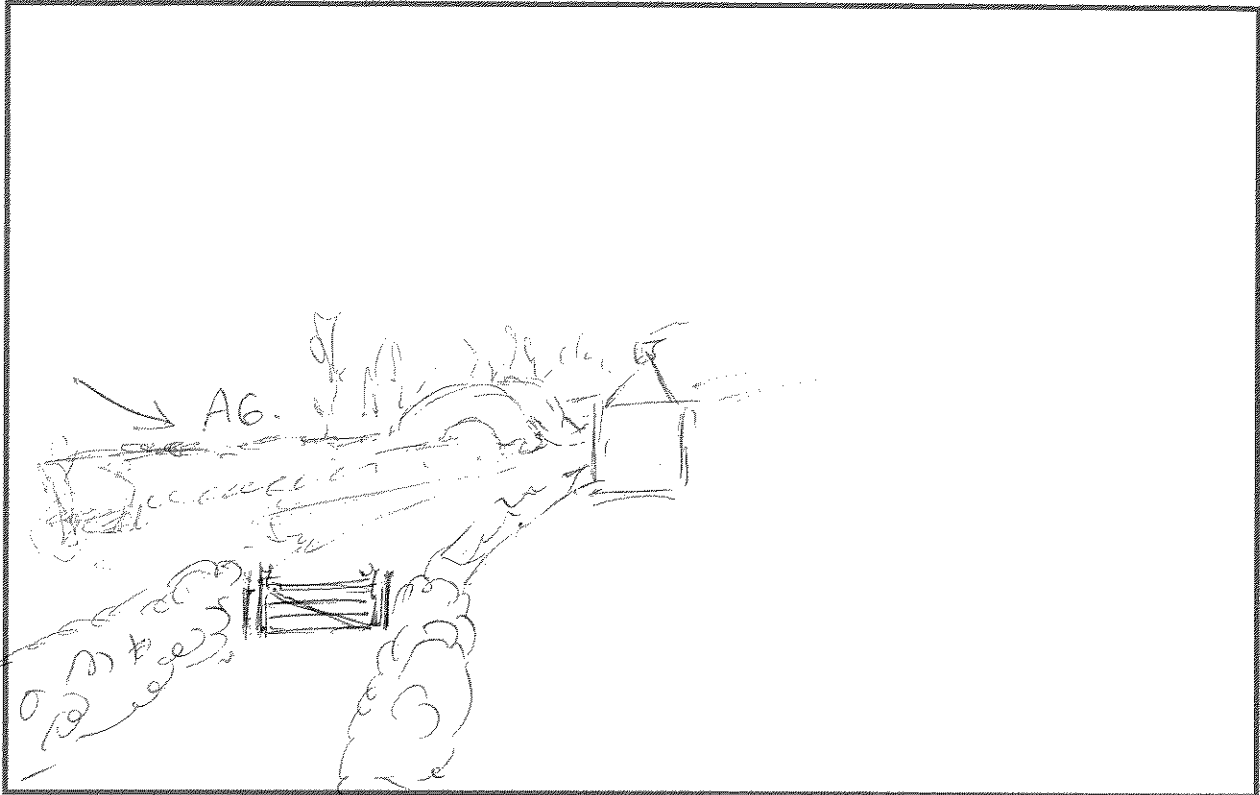

THE ROUTE FROM THE JUNCTION OF MOUNT PLEASANT LANE AND THWAITE BROW WOOD AND PROCEEDS NORTH ENDING BY THE CANAL AT THE AG. THE FIRST PART OF THE PATH HAS HARD CORE AND SOME PAVING THIS IS TO MOUNT PLEASANT HOUSE AND FARM. IT IS EASILY WIDE ENOUGH FOR VEHICLES AND HORSES TO PASS. THE ROUTE NARROWS AFTER A BARN ON THE LEFT AND A SMALL Paddock ON THE RIGHT THAT USUALLY CONTAINS A PIG. THE ROUTE SKIRTS THE TOP OF MOUNT PLEASANT FM AND DROPS DOWN BETWEEN HEDGES AND FIELDS. HALF WAY BETWEEN THE FARM AND THWAITE COTTAGE THE ROUTE IS STONEY AND IS CROSSED BY A SMALL STREAM. THERE IS A GATE SOUTH OF THWAITE COTTAGE, IT IS ALWAYS CLOSED BUT NEVER LOCKED. AFTER THWAITE COTTAGE THE ROUTE GOES NORTH EAST FOR ABOUT 100 M TO THE CANAL BRIDGE, THEN CROSSES OVER THE CANAL BRIDGE TO A JUNCTION WITH THE AG.

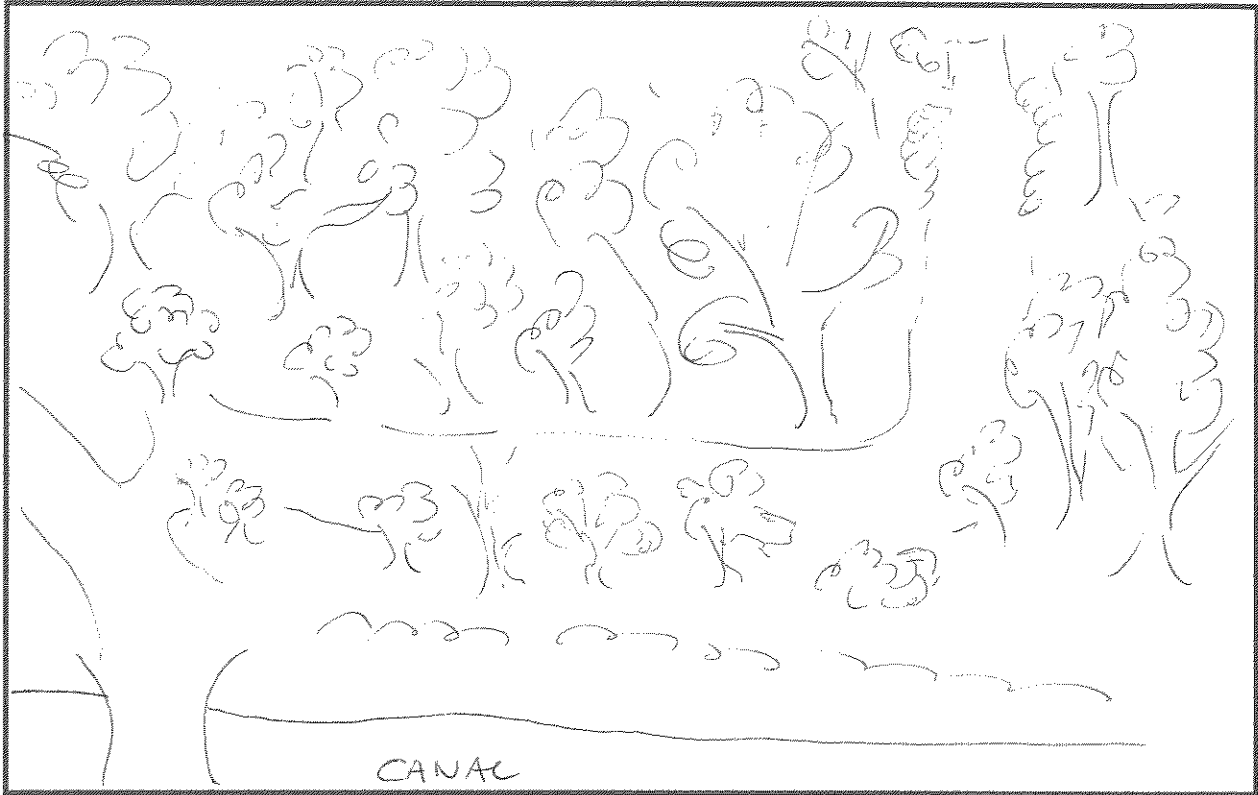

THE ROUTE HEADS OFF THWAITE BROW LANE INTO THWAITE BROW WOOD ABOUT 15 METERS NORTH EAST OF THE CANAL BRIDGE. THE TRACK CURVES AROUND THE BOTTEM OF THE WOOD IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION BEFORE GOING EAST THROUGH THE WOOD AND UPHILL TO A JUNCTION WITH MOUNT PLEASANT LANE. ITS LENGTH IS APPROXIMATELY 600 METERS AND IS PLENTY WIDE ENOUGH FOR PEOPLE AND HORSES TO PASS.

From Thwaite Brow Lane, the track that goes east through the woods up to Mount Pleasant. The track leaves Thwaite Brow Lane approximately 15m NE of the canal bridge. The track goes south, then east through the woods and uphill to a junction with Mount Pleasant. Overall it goes on for about 600m and along its length is wide enough for horses and people to pass.

Then Mount Pleasant Lane from the junction with the path from Thwaite Brow Woods, going north to ultimately meet the A6 after the canal bridge. This route is paved/hardcore for the first c.500m, up to Mount Pleasant house and farm. It is wide enough for vehicles and horses to pass. Continuing north after Mount Pleasant Farm the route goes gently downhill, between hedges and fields. There is a gate just south of Thwaite Cottage. The gate is often closed but not locked. After Thwaite Brow Cottage the route goes NE for approx 100m to a canal bridge, then crosses over the canal bridge and ends at a junction with the A6.
