## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(FAIRFIELD ROAD, POULTON LE FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Fairfield Road, Poulton le Fylde for approximately 20 metres either side of Singleton Station.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative <u>nightly</u> from **2100 hours** to **0600 hours** on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2025 until Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Station Road – Lodge Lane – Garstang Road – Garstang Road East – Hardhorn Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow culvert repair works to be carried out by Core Highways Regions on behalf of Network Rail.
