## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(STAYNALL LANE, STALMINE WITH STAYNALL, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Staynall Lane, Stalmine with Staynall from outside Banks Farm Cottage to its junction with Wardleys Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1700 hours on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2025 until Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Hall Gate Lane - Cemetery Lane - Back Lane - Burrows Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow excavation of a joint bay for a new car charging connection point to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
