The above Order was made by Lancashire County Council on 13 January 2021. An Objection to the Order has been received and the county council has not been able to secure the withdrawal of this objection. I am therefore, referring the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for formal determination.

In this case, the county council is supporting the Order.
