MRS JANE REYNOLDS

- My name is Jane Reynolds and I am the daughter of Mr John Charles Ryle who sadly died in 2021. I am now the joint owner (with my brother) of Church House (or 72 Main Street), Wray, Lancaster, LA2 8QF.
- I received a letter from Lancashire County Council addressed to my late father in October 2024. The letter contained a draft witness statement which had been prepared detailing the evidence submitted by my father in relation to his use of the pathway from Wennington Road to Home Farm Close.
- 3. I contacted the County Council to explain that my father had sadly died and to explain that I could corroborate the details even though he is no longer able to do so himself. I explained that I hoped that it could still be taken as his evidence as it was derived from his user evidence statement which he completed and signed on 26th February 2020.
- 4. My parents moved to Wray in 1967 and lived in their house there until they both died. I was born in 1968 and grew up in Wray, living there permanently until 1986, and have been back hundreds of times since then to visit my

parents. During that time, I also regularly walked from our house across the school field and then along the Order route through the passageway next to number 32 Wennington Road.

 Like my father, I to believed this to be a public footpath and was never stopped or challenged when using it.
