(HAYHURST STREET, DERBY STREET AND BOLLAND PROSPECT, CLITHEROE, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Ribble Valley Borough:
 - i. Hayhurst Street, Clitheroe from approximately the southern boundary of property number 38 to approximately the northern boundary of property number 26.
 - ii. Derby Street, Clitheroe from Hayhurst Street, Clitheroe to approximately the northeastern boundary of property number 1.
 - iii. Bolland Prospect, Clitheroe from Hayhurst Street, Clitheroe to approximately the southwestern boundary of the property 27 to 34 Pendle Court.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1400 hours on Thursday 14th November 2024 until 2359 hours on Monday 18th November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Diversion routes will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to a leaking water service to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
