(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Rear 85-105 Victoria Road West, Thornton Cleveleys outside the sub-station for approximately 10 metres in both an easterly and westerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours until 2359 hours on Tuesday 19th November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the continuation of immediate works to repair underground low voltage mains to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
