(U348 SANDY WAY, HOLMESWOOD, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U348 Sandy Way, Holmeswood from X101 Sandy Lane, Holmeswood to the northern boundary of the property named Oak Dene.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 3rd December 2024 until 1700 hours on Thursday 5th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

U348 Sandy Way, Holmeswood – B5246 Holmeswood Road, Rufford – U329 Chapel Lane, Rufford – U50102 Cross Meanygate, Rufford and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new water connection installation works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
