EDITH RIGBY WAY, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Edith Rigby Way, Preston from its junction with William Young Way to its junction with Avice Pimblett Way.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative overnight from 2100 hours until 0500 hours from Tuesday 17th December 2024 until Wednesday 18th December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

William Young Way – Tabley Lane – Tag Lane - Tom Benson Way – Avice Pimblett Way and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is for the completion of the PWDR works to be carried out.
