EDITH RIGBY WAY, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Edith Rigby Way, Preston from its junction with William Young Way to its junction with Avice Pimblett Way.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative overnight from 2100 hours until 0500 hours from Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2024 until Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

William Young Way – Tabley Lane – Tag Lane - Tom Benson Way – Avice Pimblett Way and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is for the completion of the PWDR works to be carried out.
